STATEMENT FROM CLERK

181.16 The Clerk advised the meeting that the May 2016 meeting was to be re-convened by the Vice-chairman of the Parish Council at 7.30pm, having been adjourned sine die on 14th May 2016.

OPENING OF RE-CONVENED MEETING

182.16 The Vice-chairman of the Parish Council took the Chair for the meeting since no Parish Council Chairman was in place and at the time of the adjournment the position of the Vice-chairman had not been vacated.

183.16 The Vice-chairman opened the re-convened meeting stating that the June meeting of the Parish Council would be held on closure of the re-convened May 2016 meeting.

APOLOGIES

184.16 The Clerk advised he had received apologies for absence from Cllrs Derek Burt, Jane Wilson and Tony Higgins and an apology for possible late arrival from Purbeck DC Cllr Malcolm Barnes.

PUBLIC DISCUSSION PERIOD

185.16 There being no members of the public, or Parishioners, present there was no public discussion.

POSTPONEMENTS OF ITEMS ON THE AGENDA TO JUNE MEETING

186.16 Cllr Hollard proposed, seconded by Cllr Best, that items 5,6,8,15,17,18,19 & 20 be postponed for discussion to the June 2016 meeting. This was unanimously agreed to by Members present.

MINUTES OF THE APRIL 2016 MEETING

187.16 These had been circulated before the meeting and read by Members. It was proposed by Cllr Edwards and seconded by Cllr Page that they were a true record of the proceedings and should be adopted as minutes of the meeting concerned. Members unanimously voted to adopt the minutes as a true record.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

188.16 Cllr Page gave a point of information regarding Minute 139.16 in that he had been advised that the CRB were 6 months behind in processing CRB check applications. Cllr Hollard commented that he knew of an applicant whose application had been "turned around" in 6 days.

187.16 Cllr Bugler advised Members that with regard to Minute No 148.16 there had been no further progress on his removing the finger post arms at Grange Road.

188.16 Cllrs Parker and Page advised the Meeting that they had nothing of significance to report from the Swanage Railway liaison meeting.
